Hospitals and labs are facing shortage of ventilators, testing kits, and personal protective equipment (PPE). Considering this, PnP would like to appeal for donation of ventilators, COVID testing kits, and personal protection equipment (PPE) to be distributed in hospitals and labs in Uttarakhand, Andhra Pradesh and Rajasthan, where we work actively.

We will only be accepting ventilators, and testing kits that is approved by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHF&W), Government of India. The Central Government has directed that commercial kits for real time Polymerase chain reaction (PCR) based diagnosis of COVID-19 should be USDA approved or European CE Certified or both for *in vitro* diagnosis of COVID-19 under emergency use, under intimation to Drug Controller General of India (DCGI) of MoHF&W. Nucleic acid extraction kits and other reagents should be of standard quality.

We are also open to receive donations in our bank account which will be used for purchase of ventilators, testing kits and PPE for distribution to hospitals, and labs.
